YANMAR 8LV IS BANANA SHAR RACES AHEAD WITH YANMAR



The new Yanmar 8LV, 4.46 litre twin-turbo, V8 diesel engine was introduced in the UK at the 2011 Southampton Boat Show. The 8LV engine, coupled to a stern drive or gearbox, is available at 320hp (239kW) and 370hp (272kW).



This compact engine can be installed in single or twin configuration with the new hydrodynamic Yanmar ZT370 dual propeller stern drive or KMH50 series transmission, down angle or V-drive. It has a twin turbocharger and common rail fuel injection for superior performance in terms of fuel efficiency and acceleration.

In the Yanmar tradition of high power from low weight, the dry engine weight is just 450kg. This is the first engine to use Yanmar's own, newly developed CAN-bus vessel control system, the Yanmar VCS.

It can be ordered with the new joy stick. facilitating 360" turn, sideways and diagonal movement. A key feature of the high torque 8LV is its wide power band. It idles at 550rpm capable of crawling speed in the marina, aided further by a hydraulic clutch with both sterndrive and gear configurations. Maximum engine speed is 3,800 rpm - well ahead of other engines of this type.

Further benefits include exceptionally low noise levels and reduced vibration, ease of installation and servicing, and the advantage of a powerful 12V/180A alternator. The 8LV is expected to appeal to a wide variety of boat builders producing craft up to 45 feet (14 metres) for applications ranging from water skiing to cruising. Additionally, the engine will be ideal for repowering; offering the advantages of diesel over similar sized gasoline units.



BANANA SHARK

The Banana Shark Stirling was built in Devon as a racing machine. The Banana Shark owner and racing team leader is John Cooke, an experienced marine consultant, whose team consists of Graham Lawton, the National OCR champion of 2010 and Jeremy Gibson another highly experienced OCR racer. The Banana Shark is 39' long, and has two economical Yanmar 260hp engines. These were derived from the current 3 litre BMW engine. The boat is designed to go fast; therefore the engine is attached to the Arneson surface drives, enabling it to travel over 70mph.

The crew consists of three or four crew members; a driver behind the steering wheel, a throttleman in charge of all throttles, and behind the throttleman, a navigator directing the other crew members. These three positions are linked to one another by the Raymarine network. This hi-tech system aids the crew in finding their way around, as well as keeping them informed and updated in their fuel consumption levels, monitoring the engines' data, and showing them where other boats are nearby. At the Southampton Boat show this year, two of our Barrus employees had the chance to ride in the Banana Shark, leading the boat show procession before being taken out for a spin! Madeleine Burns, from Brookes University Oxford working on a 12 month marketing placement with Barrus said, "It was amazing, but absolutely terrifying, I had to keep calming myself down!" whilst Darren Thomas, marine diesel sales coordinator, commented "It was a once in a lifetime opportunity!"





The new Pascoe SY9 range has been designed as a multirole Superyacht tender offering the space and layout to cater for the needs of any large luxury yacht. It is particularly well suited for diving and other watersports use as well as for yacht to shore movements for guests and crew.

The hull, deck and mouldings are constructed in high gloss gel-coated GRP/Kevlar Aramid composites with Divinycell foam stiffening. The tapered buoyancy collar is manufactured in 1200gsm Hypalon. All of the components are high quality to ensure long life and serviceability.

The tender has a sound proofed engine access hatch with integrated seating, and an automatic engine bay fire extinguisher.





The Pascoe SY9 is the first application in the UK to be fitted with the new Yanmar V8, twin-turbo diesel engine. The 8LV, 370hp engine, has a Yanmar ZT370 twin propeller stern drive, fly-by-wire controls and Latham Marine power steering offering finger tip control. The engine has low speed handling and acceleration which makes it ideal for tender operations.



Bristol and Birmingham airports have decided to take on the winter snow this year in an attempt to eliminate cancellations and delays this winter. Both airports have purchased the new Multihog MH90 multi-purpose implement carriers, which have been designed to brush away snow and ice.

The Multihog multi-purpose vehicle is designed to tackle a whole manner of grounds maintenance tasks with efficiency and ease by utilising a multitude of inter-changeable attachments. It is the ideal vehicle to tackle snow clearance and de-icing around parked aircrafts at the airports. Multihog has chosen the reliable Yanmar 4TNV98T engine, and have fitted them in all of their new snow utility vehicles. The popular water-cooled engines satisfy original equipment manufacturers' requirements in achieving reductions in noise levels and lightweight portability.

Front attachments for the two Multihog MH90 vehicles are hydraulically operated, spring-loaded, 2.4m wide snow ploughs for initial clearance and snow brushes for a back to black surface. De-mountable de-icing chemical tanks with a 1,200 litre capacity and variable spray widths are fitted to the rear of the vehicles. Bristol airport found that keeping aircrafts clear of snow and ice had proved challenging and labour intensive, and therefore decided to go for a cost effective solution, commenting "when we saw the

Multihog in action we realised that we had found the answer". Rob Cooke, Head of Aerodrome Operations at Birmingham airport, commented, "the specialist nature of the Multihog and its excellent visibility from the cab will enable it to get up close to the aircraft for a safe and clean sweep".

Once any risk of bad weather is over, the Multihog's versatility to work with an almost endless array of attachments means there are many other uses for it during the summer months whilst the winter maintenance kit is in storage.

The Yanmar commercial marine diesel engine range will be further strengthened with the introduction of the 12AY series engine at the beginning of 2012. With a maximum output of 1340kW, 1822hp, this power horse will target an even wider range of commercial vessels.



John Deere engines have been specified to power a fleet of four specially designed harbour patrol launches for the Port of London Authority (PLA). Built by Alnmaritec, based in Alnwick, Northumberland, the aluminium catamarans, with deep vee hull form were designed by Newcastle University, and will operate in the Middle and Lower Districts of the Tidal Thames, between Putney Bridge and the North Sea.

Twin installation John Deere 6068TFM, 200hp marine diesel engines were chosen for their robustness and compatibility with keel cooling, providing optimised vessel reliability. Lambeth, the first of the new launches has completed extensive engineering and operational trials which demonstrated the benefits of substantially reduced exhaust emissions, lower fuel consumption and smaller wash. The first three, 'Lambeth', 'Kew' and 'Southwark' are already in operation on the River

Thames, and the fourth, 'Barnes', will be launched soon.

Barrus' latest project with Alnmaritec is to build up to three pilot boats for DAB VLOOT, a commercial operator based in Germany. One of the first commercial specification high-speed Yanmar engines has been specified for the project, the Yanmar 6LY2-WST. DAB VLOOT has taken delivery of the first boat, and the next two are currently in full production.

A century after the race to the South Pole that gripped the world, two teams of British soldiers are to retrace the steps of Scott and Amundsen to raise money for their injured colleagues.

On November 3, Lt Col Henry Worsley MBE led his team on the Amundsen route and WÖ2 Mark Langadge MC led his team along Scott's route. Amunidaan's route to the Pole crosses the Ross toe Shelf and then ascends the short, but our ishlingly steep and dangerous Axel Heiberg pledier. Scott's route crosses the same shalf but then takes the longer, shallower Beardmore Glacier, For both Learns, glacier crossings punctualise by hidden crevasses up to a mile deep will be panious in the extreme.

Both teams are completely unsupported and will carry their food and fuel across the ice for seventy days. The modern race is likely to be very closely run, and if all goes well, both teams will complete their journey in two months, arriving at the South Pole by January 2012


